**Register for your classes online:**

**1. Meet with your advisor by May 9** to select classes. Advisors will have registration cards and will need to grant your registration clearance.

**2. Register online using myUIU.** Choose the term “07 – 08 Fayette Summer Term I or 07 – 08 Fayette Summer Term II”.

Seniors only: April 9 – 11

Juniors & Seniors: April 14 – 16

All students: April 17 – June 1 (for Summer Term I)

July 10 (for Summer Term II)
