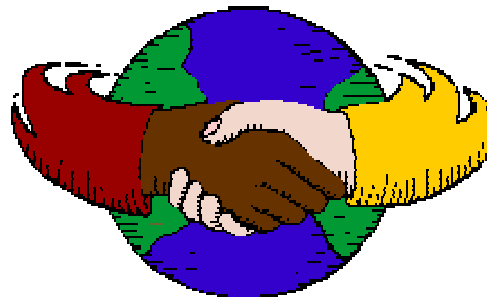
Our hope is through this program a bond will develop between the international students and the Northeast Iowa community; creating goodwill ambassadors, future friends and a deeper connection to America and American culture.
