*RECOMMENDED ELECTIVES:

It is recommended that students select free elective courses for 6 credits from the articulation course-to-course list to receive as much course equivalent credits as possible for transfer to UIU.

****A maximum of 60 credits from Associate Degrees at FVTC are guaranteed to transfer to Upper Iowa University baccalaureate degrees.**

Junior status is awarded after completion of an Associate Degree at FVTC. Students can complete the BS degree within two years of transfer via learning center, online or external degree (independent study) courses.

*****120 semester credits are required for the Bachelor of Science Degree. Students need an additional 60 semester credits to complete a Bachelor's Degree with UIU. Of the 60 credits needed at Upper Iowa University, a minimum of 30 credits must be upper division credits. Upper division credits are 300-400 level courses earned at a four-year university or college. Credits evaluated by the American Council of Education, as being upper division will meet this requirement, as will Experiential Learning Portfolios based on 300-400 level course requirements.**

A minimum of 30 semester credits must be earned at UIU. These 30 may be earned through a combination of learning center, independent study and online UIU courses.
