\*\*\*Of the 60 credits needed at Upper Iowa University, a minimum of 30 credits must be upper division credits. Upper division credits are 300-400 level courses earned at a four-year university or college. Credits evaluated by the American Council of Education, as being upper division will meet this requirement, as will Experiential Learning Portfolios based on 300-400 level course requirements. Of the 30 upper division credits earned by each learner, 15 credits must be earned in courses in the accounting major.
