



The Art Program at Upper Iowa University, Fayette Campus, invites applications for a new, tenure track, Assistant Professor of Art beginning August 2010. The successful applicant will hold an MFA, PhD or equivalent terminal degree.

This Art History position includes teaching Introduction to Art, Art History I & II, Survey of American Art, and Non-Western Art to both majors and non-majors. In addition, this person will develop new course offerings in 20th Century Art and History of Graphic Design. The successful applicant will join three current art faculty in a newly remodeled facility that features four studios, one computer lab, a lecture hall, and gallery space. Class sizes are relatively small and faculty are committed to mentoring and advising students.

Teaching assignments are predominantly face-to-face on the Fayette campus, but may require teaching as needed in hybrid, online, domestic center, and international center modalities. The successful applicant is expected to complete eCollege training during the 2010-2011 academic year.
